Class of 2019-2021 Credit Recovery

Frequently Asked Questions

When is the deadline to register for the Class of 2019, 2020 and 2021 Credit Recovery? Students must be registered by their high school counselor no later than June 14, 2019.

Who is eligible for Credit Recovery?

Class of 2019, 2020 and 2021 students who receive a final failing mark in a course required to graduate and receive a diploma are eligible to register for a make-up course in Summer Credit Recovery.

When will classes begin?

All registered students must report to Pittsburgh Sci-Tech 6-12 on Monday, July 1 to pick up their schedules and begin their classes. They will enter through the Bouquet Street entrance. Each make-up class will meet for 1½ hours a day, five days a week.

How many courses can I take?

Students may take up to four courses during this program, not including the graduation project and/or portfolio.

What are the attendance requirements?

Summer School operates for only 20 days, which makes it imperative that students be present every day. School attendance will be counted every day including the first day, Monday, July 1st. There will be no school on Thursday, July 4th. Students, who are absent, no matter what the reason, for more than 2 days, or tardy more than 4 times, will be dropped from their course(s) without credit.

What is the cost for the program?

There is no fee for this program.

How many credits can I earn for making up required course work?

Students may earn ½ credit for the successful 30-hour completion of each make-up course they take.

How will my credits be calculated?

Repeating a course for the purpose of making up a failing mark will not remove the previous mark from the permanent record. Both marks will be included in the computation of Grade Point Average and class rank.

Is transportation provided?

Students are responsible for their own transportation to Summer School. Students who drive are not permitted to park on school property.

Will breakfast and lunch be available?

Breakfast and lunch will be available. Vending machines will be open. Lunchroom space will be provided for those students who bring their lunches. Students may not leave the campus for lunch. Students who leave will not be allowed to return.

If I make up my required classes, when will I received my diploma?

Class of 2019 students who complete their graduation requirements in Summer School may pick up their diplomas from their home high schools in September.
