Special 12 Credit Recovery Program

Need to Recover Course Credit?

This program is for students who are in need of more than 2 credits (4 semester courses) to receive their diploma. The program will allow for students to recover up to 1.5 credits of instruction. Students can attend the program at Pittsburgh Science and Technology 6-12, from June 17, 2019 - June 28, 2019 from 7:30 AM until 2:35 PM, with the opportunity to enroll in the Summer Credit Recovery Program following the Special 12 Senior Credit Recovery. This will allow them to recover 3.5 credits of instruction or 7 semester courses.

Talk to your school counselor. Sign up by May 17th.

Frequently Asked Questions

When is the deadline to register for the Class of 2019 Special 12 Credit Recovery?

Students must be registered by their high school counselor no later than May 17, 2019.

Who is eligible for Credit Recovery?

Class of 2019 students who are in need of more than 2 credits (4 semester courses) to receive their diploma. Students will then enroll in Credit Recovery that begins July 1st to make up the additional credits needed to graduate.

When will classes begin?

All registered students must report to Pittsburgh Sci-Tech 6-12 on Monday, June 17th to pick up their schedules and begin their classes. They will enter through the Bouquet Street entrance. Each make-up class will meet for 2 hours a day, five days a week for ten days.

How many courses can I take?

Students may take up to three courses during this program.

What are the attendance requirements?

Summer School operates for only 10 days, which makes it imperative that students be present every day. School attendance will be counted every day including the first day, Monday, June 17th. Students, who are absent, no matter what the reason, for more than 1 day, or tardy more than 4 times, will be dropped from their course(s) without credit.

What is the cost for the program?

There is no fee for this program.

How many credits can I earn for making up required course work?

Students may earn ½ credit for the successful 30-hour completion of each make-up course they take. To meet the requirements for completion, students will be required to continue their work on courses online at home.

How will my credits be calculated?

Repeating a course for the purpose of making up a failing mark will not remove the previous mark from the permanent record. Both marks will be included in the computation of Grade Point Average and class rank.

Is transportation provided?

Students are responsible for their own transportation to Summer School. Students who drive are not permitted to park on school property.

Will breakfast and lunch be available?

Breakfast and lunch will be available. Vending machines will be open. Lunchroom space will be provided for those students who bring their lunches. Students may not leave the campus for lunch. Students who leave will not be allowed to return.

If I make up my required classes, when will I received my diploma?

Class of 2019 students who complete their graduation requirements in Summer School may pick up their diplomas from their home high schools in September.
