Forecasted Temperatures Prompt District to Activate Extreme Heat Protocol

Students and Staff at 38 Facilities to Transition to Remote Learning due to Severely High Temperatures

PITTSBURGH, September 4, 2023 –Today, Superintendent, Dr. Wayne N. Walters activated the District’s [Extreme Heat Protocol](#), transitioning students and staff at 38 facilities to remote teaching and learning Tuesday, September 5, and Wednesday September 6, 2023. Teachers will facilitate live remote instruction on Microsoft Teams. District schools notified families on Friday of the possible transition. Grab and Go meal service will be available at 19 locations across the District.
