THE ASPIRING LEADERS PROGRAM

Executive Summary

The Aspiring Leaders Program (ALP), a yearlong intensive program designed to build the capacity of the District's next generation of school leaders, is now entering the second phase of the program, which is a school-based practicum. This practicum will require mentor principals for each of the ten aspiring leaders.

PRACTICUM AND MENTOR PRINCIPALS

Selection of mentor principals

Mentor principals have been selected based on the recommendations of the Assistant Superintendents, Chief of School Performance, and Instructional Leadership Specialist. In making their nominations, this team from the Office of School Performance considered the following four factors: (1) principals' educational leadership abilities, (2) their communication skills and willingness to share their practice, (3) TLC data, and (4) experience serving as a Principal.

Responsibilities of mentor principals

Principal mentors will attend at least one (1) three-hour training session with their mentee, while also providing on-the-job shadowing experiences two days per month. They will also be expected to share best practices, experience-based learning, and leadership knowledge on an ongoing basis. In addition, mentor principals are responsible for assisting mentees with completing their 90-day culminating project.

Mentorship Pairings

The following chart provides current mentorship pairings. Mentees were paired with mentors based on their differentiated needs while also considering leadership skills of the principals.
