


Jack (Not Jackie) by Erica Silverman Illustrated by Holly Hatam

Activities:

For instance, perhaps somebody (a sister, brother, friend, parent, teacher) thinks of you as being one way, but you are actually another way. Draw that. Or, perhaps you like being different ways at different moments. What would you look like during those moments? How would you feel? Choose one of those to draw. You can divide the box below in two for your pictures if you would like.
2. Alternatively, instead of drawing pictures, you can act out these different versions of yourself. What version feels the most comfortable to you?
