Pittsburgh Public Schools to Unveil New Report Highlighting Shocking Number of School Bus Stop-Arm Violations

Pittsburgh Public Schools (PPS) will hold a press conference to unveil its *School Bus Stop-Arm Violation Report Card* that will highlight the number of school bus stop-arm violations that have occurred over the past six months. In addition, PPS will also release exclusive footage that was caught on camera showing some of the most egregious illegal school bus passings in the community.

School District officials will be joined by community members to address the public safety challenges posed by these violators and what additional actions will be taken to remind motorists to stop for the school bus and protect students.

Last year, PPS launched a school bus camera safety program that utilizes automated photo-enforcement technology to empower law enforcement to reduce the number of school bus violations and protect children.
