Students and Staff at Five Facilities to Transition to Synchronous Remote Learning Due to Special Election Tuesday, September 19th

PITTSBURGH, September 14, 2023 – Students and staff at five facilities – Pittsburgh Schiller 6-8, Pittsburgh Spring Garden Early Childhood Center, Pittsburgh Spring Hill K-5, Pittsburgh Sunnyside PreK-8, and Pittsburgh Woolslair PreK-5 - will transition to synchronous learning, September 19. All five facilities will serve as sites for Tuesday’s Special Election. The move will remedy concerns related to the overlap of student arrival and the opening of polls to the general public. Students will participate in live synchronous learning and instruction remotely. Staff will report to the schools at their regular starting time and will teach their classes synchronously on Teams. Both staff and families at each location were notified about the transition earlier this week.
