

## **2012 Charter School Results**



## 2012 changes in calculations make it easier for charter schools to Make AYP.

Beginning in 2012, AYP calculations for charter schools was similar to how Districts make AYP. Charter schools are now able to make AYP by meeting the targets in only one grade span instead of all tested grades.

This allows a K-8 charter school to make AYP based on either 3-5 or 6-8 grade spans instead of grades 3-8 (how AYP for K-8 school is calculated).

Two charter schools that Made AYP this year would not have under the previous calculation (Manchester Academic and Environmental Charter).
