- 6 We only have one item this evening, and it
- 7 is a Personnel Report from the Superintendent.
- As you can see, it is the hiring of three
- 9 people, three positions to be filled.
- 10 Are there any questions?
- Mr. Brentley.
- MR. BRENTLEY: Yes. I just want to make a
- 13 comment.
- I will be voting no for these items.
- I have raised some concerns in the past
- 16 about the role and the responsibility of the Board to
- 17 be involved with some level of selection of employees.
- 18 My particular concern for No. 1 is I
- 19 don't -- I don't know any of the individuals, first,
- 20 but to hire a principal at the Oliver High School,
- 21 which is a challenging school, I thought should have
- 22 taken a little bit more time, and if necessary, even
- 23 reach out, as we did in some of the other high
- 24 schools.
- We were very careful when we made the

- 1 selection for Allderdice, and we should have treated
- 2 this the same way here.
- 3 It is a challenging high school.
- 4 My concern is, is that we have quite a few
- 5 individuals within the District, some have
- 6 certification for superintendency, some have
- 7 certifications for principals, but yet we are still
- 8 not tapping into that talent that we have here.
- 9 I know very little, or nothing about this
- 10 individual, other than what was shared with us in a
- 11 resume. May be a good candidate.
- But what are we doing to the morale of
- 13 individuals, who are here, who aren't even given the
- 14 courtesy of giving an interview, of given the courtesy
- 15 of even being evaluated, before we bring in folks from
- 16 outside the District.
- So I will not be supporting.
- And the No. 3 is new to me, I don't even
- 19 remember seeing -- receiving the resume on this
- 20 candidate, but we had it last week.
- So I will be voting no again.
- 22 And I will ask again that this
- 23 administration find a way to evaluate our staff,
- 24 especially those who have expressed interest in
- 25 becoming principals, or vice principals, provide some

- 1 kind of communications with those candidates, and with
- 2 the Board as well, and I will ask again, I'd like to
- 3 see a list, how many candidates do we have in this
- 4 District who have the certification.
- 5 Have we had conversation, and have we
- 6 evaluated them, to -- or, accurately, and have we
- 7 openly and honestly tapped into their talents to be
- 8 considered for promotion.
- 9 It is great to bring in new blood, but we
- 10 know in the past that has not worked out all the time,
- 11 and we are stepping over, bypassing, and maybe in some
- 12 cases, may even be considered discriminatory, in not
- 13 looking at local candidates, with certification, and
- 14 with experience.
- So I will be voting no on this item.
- MR. ISLER: Thank you, Mr. Brentley.
- 17 Any other comments or questions?
- 18 Hearing none, Mr. Weiss, could we please
- 19 have a roll call vote on the Report on Personnel, as
- 20 submitted.
- MR. WEISS: Mrs. Arnet?
