- 4 every year PJC, the grid adjusts what the pass through
- 5 charges are.
- 6 We, including the pass through charges, are
- 7 7.01 cents per kilowatt hour on our current contract,
- 8 so our extension will be cheaper.
- 9 The estimated savings for a three year
- 10 period, is close to \$200,000.
- The most important piece, I would point
- 12 out, is versus your ten-year forecast, it's a huge
- 13 improvement.
- And I put a graphic on the wall so the
- 15 Board can understand why now, you can see, this is a
- 16 graphic that goes from Jan. 1 of 2007 to the present
- 17 time, this is a great time to lock in some electricity
- 18 forward pricing.
- MR. ISLER: Thank you.

- 23 because we are paying less now than we were in the
- 24 past one.
