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Pittsburgh Miller Transitions to Synchronous Teaching and Learning for Remainder of Week

PITTSBURGH, May 18, 2022 – Pittsburgh Miller PreK-5 will transition to synchronous remote instruction for the remainder of the week due to a staffing shortage caused by positive cases of COVID-19, exposure-related quarantines, and other staff absences. Instruction will move to Microsoft Teams, and students will access work in Schoology. The day will follow the regular bell schedule, and Grab and Go meal service will be available to students at the school from 9 AM – Noon Thursday and Friday. As a result of the transition to synchronous (live streaming) educational instruction, the school's Take a Father to School Day activities planned for this Friday will now take place virtually.

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
