## **Pittsburgh CAPA Facility Closed for Three Days for COVID-19 Mitigation**

PITTSBURGH, May 9, 2022 – After exceeding its 5 percent threshold for positive cases of COVID-19, with 38 cases reported today, the Pittsburgh CAPA 6-12 facility will close until Friday, May 13, 2022, to support disinfecting and deep cleaning of the facility. No one may enter the building until Friday, May 13, and all special events and activities are canceled. Upon return, the use of well-fitting masks will be required for all staff, students, and visitors at the school until Friday, May 20, 2022, unless Allegheny County's community level reaches medium.

Students and staff will transition to synchronous (live streaming) educational instruction during the building closure. Instead of reporting to the school building, instruction will move to Microsoft Teams, and students will access work in Schoology. The day will follow the regular bell schedule.
