Hold my child accountable for completing all assigned work to the best of their ability and turning homework in on time.	Establish ongoing communications with parents by sharing student progress including positive feedbac and scheduling parent conferences as needed. Parents can discuss their child's progress at any time by emailing, calling, or writing to their child's teacher. Staff members will return all parent correspondence in a timely manner (24 hrs.).
		Parents will have an opportunity to meet with staff at the Back-to-School Night, annual parent conferences (October 09, 2023), and at monthly parent and family engagement activities. Ensure that parents have access to classroom assessments in a timely manner through the Home Access Center.
		The school will share student progress through interim reports and weeklies, which include behavioral and academic reports.
		The school will provide parents with opportunities to volunteer, participate in their child's class and to observe classroom activities.
		Communication to parents will occur in their home language. Parents can request an interpreter when needed to communicate with staff. Staff will have access to a translation service to communicate with families in their home language.
