Monitor and ask questions about my grades and performance	Check the Home Access Center, and check my child's daily communication folder, progress report, and report cards	Prepare frequent updates on student progress via, Home Access center, progress reports, and report cards. Interim reports will be sent home four times a year with students halfway through the quarter
Follow classroom and school rules, be respectful to all staff and students; know and follow all rules outlined in the Student Code of Conduct.
