Toni Corinealdi is the Neighborhood Allies Senior Program Manager of Empowerment and Outreach, where she oversees Fund My Future PGH. Fund My Future is a program that aims to encourage saving for your child's future and educates on healthy savings habits. She oversees a county-wide expansion of Fund My Future PGH partnered with the Pennsylvania State Treasury, making the PA ABLE savings opportunity available to all families in Pennsylvania. Toni's vision is that ALL children in Allegheny County have a basic savings account by the start of school, giving children a jumpstart on life, building their confidence, and preparing them to reach their lifetime goals.

Diana Fishlock is the PA ABLE Outreach Specialist for the Pennsylvania Treasury's Bureau of Consumer Programs. She shares information about the PA ABLE Savings Program throughout the state. PA ABLE Savings Program account gives individuals with qualified disabilities (eligible Individuals), and their families and friends a tax-free way to save for a wide range of disability-related expenses while maintaining government benefits. The state and federal tax-free investment options are offered to encourage (eligible Individuals) and their families to save private funds to support health, independence, and quality of life.
