Recommendation to Close 7 Schools and 7 Buildings at end of 2011-2012 School Year

SCHOOL	CLOSE/ OPEN	Student Assignment
SECONDARY SCHOOLS		
Brashear Teachers Institute 9-12	RECEIVES STUDENTS	Receives students from Langley 9-12, including 3 Regional Special Education classrooms.
Langley 9-12	SCHOOL CLOSSES / BUILDING REMAINS OPEN	Students move to Brashear Teaching Institute 9-12, including 3 Regional Special Education classrooms. Langley building becomes New K-8 school receiving students from Schaeffer K-8 and some students from Stevens K-8.
Oliver 9-12	SCHOOL CLOSSES / BUILDING REMAINS OPEN	Students move to Perry 9-12. McNaugher moves into Oliver Building along with Special Education offices currently in the Overbrook building. Receives back students from approved private placements.
Perry 9-12	RECEIVES STUDENTS	Receives students from Oliver 9-12. School goes from Full Magnet to Partial Magnet with Northside 9-12 student feeder pattern.
MIDDLE SCHOOLS		
Arsenal 6-8	BUILDING ADJUSTMENT	Arsenal PK-5 in Arsenal building receives some students from Fort Pitt PreK-5, including 1 Regional Special Education and 3 Early Childhood (EC) Classrooms, and up to 6 ECC classrooms from McCleary.
South Hills 6-8	RECEIVES STUDENTS	Receives grade 6-8 students from Westwood K-8 and some from Stevens K-8.
ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS		
Arlington PreK-8	RECEIVES STUDENTS	Receives students from Murray K-8, including 3 Regional Special Education classrooms.
Arsenal PreK-5	RECEIVES STUDENTS	Receives some students from Fort Pitt PreK-5, including 1 Regional Special Education and 3 Early Childhood (EC) Classrooms, and up to 6 ECC classrooms from McCleary.
Fort Pitt PreK-5	SCHOOL CLOSSES / BUILDING CLOSSES	Assign students to Arsenal PreK-5, Fulton PreK-5, and Woolslair K-5, including 1 Regional Special Education and 3 EC classrooms.
Fulton PreK-5	RECEIVES STUDENTS	Receives some students from Fort Pitt PreK-5.
King PreK-8	RECEIVES STUDENTS	Receives some students from Northview PreK-8.
Murray K-8	SCHOOL CLOSSES / BUILDING CLOSSES	Assign students to Arlington PreK-8, including 3 Regional Special Education classrooms.
Northview PreK-8	SCHOOL CLOSSES / BUILDING CLOSSES	Feeder pattern adjustment assigning students, including 2 Regional Special Education and 2 EC classrooms, to King PreK-8 and Morrow PreK-8.
Morrow PreK-5	RECONFIGURATION	Expands to PreK-8 using the Rooney building as an Intermediate Campus for grades 5-8. Receives some students from Northview PreK-8. Note: School will grow by adding one grade per year: 6th grade in 2012-13, 7th grade in 2013-14, and 8th grade in 2014-15. Students in grades 6-8 in the new Morrow feeder pattern will be offered choice between Allegheny and Schiller until the grade becomes available at Morrow.
Schaeffer K-3	SCHOOL CLOSSES / BUILDING CLOSSES	Assign students to New K-8 school in Langley building.
Schaeffer 4-8 @ Sheraden Building	SCHOOL CLOSSES / BUILDING CLOSSES	Assign students to New K-8 school in Langley building.
Stevens K-8	SCHOOL CLOSSES / BUILDING CLOSSES	Assign some students, including 4 Regional Special Education classrooms, to New K-8 school in Langley building and some students to Westwood K-5 and South Hills 6-8.
Westwood K-8	RECONFIGURATION	Becomes K-5 school. Grade 6-8 students are assigned to South Hills 6-8. Receives some students from Stevens K-8.
Woolslair K-5	RECEIVES STUDENTS	Receives some students from Fort Pitt PreK-5.
SPECIAL SCHOOLS		
McNaugher	MOVE PROGRAM / BUILDING CLOSSES	Moves to Oliver building along with Special Education offices currently at Overbrook. Receives back students from approved private placements.
