Heating Problems Prompt 12:30 p.m. Dismissal for Pittsburgh Alderdice Students

Parents of Pittsburgh Alderdice students have been notified, via the District parent notification system Alert Now, that school will dismiss today, December 8th, at 12:30 p.m., due to a problem with the school's heating system. Two of the school's three boilers are out of service, leaving the building without heat. The boilers are currently being repaired and will be ready for the start of the school day tomorrow.

To return home, students will use their regular transportation methods. Yellow buses will arrive at 12 noon today, and all other students will report to their regular Port Authority bus stops.
