## District to Recognize 2016 STAR Schools with Weeklong Celebration

PITTSBURGH, February 19, 2016- Next week Superintendent Linda Lane, Board Members, Assistant Superintendents and representatives from the Pittsburgh Federation of Teachers (PFT) will join staff and students at seven schools to celebrate their extraordinary academic growth. STAR stands for Students and Teachers Achieving Results and is a rewards and recognition program in the Pittsburgh Public Schools. STAR awards school staff for making great gains in student achievement.

Beginning Monday, four schools (Pittsburgh Arsenal 6-8, Faison PreK-5, Lincoln PreK-5 and WoolslairPreK-5) will be recognized for ranking among the top 25 percent of all other Pennsylvania schools based upon student growth, as averaged over two years. This is the second year in a row the four schools will receive STAR recognition. Additionally, three of the District's special schools (Pittsburgh Conroy, Pittsburgh Student Achievement Center and Pittsburgh Pioneer) will receive recognition based on meeting STAR student outcome criteria based on each school's student population.

Pittsburgh Federation of Teacher (PFT) represented staff at STAR schools will receive up to \$6,000 in compensation.
