As reported on the 2018 Future Ready Index, the Urban Pathways 6-12 Charter School (UP 6-12) did not meet statewide goals/interim targets on performance for the All, Black, Economically Disadvantaged (ED), and Student with Disabilities (SWD) student groups in ELA and Math; the All, Black, and ED student groups in Science. The school showed declines in the All and Black student groups in ELA; the All, Black, and ED student groups in Math; the All student group in Science.

UP 6-12 did not meet statewide goals/interim targets for growth for the Black and ED student groups ELA.

The school did not meet the statewide goal/interim target for attendance for all student groups.

The school did not meet the statewide goal/interim target for High School Graduation for the All student group.

The school did not meet the statewide goal/interim target for the Career Standards Benchmark for any student group.
