Pittsburgh Milliones Facility Closed Until December 4 Arsenal Facility Closed Until November 30

PITTSBURGH November 23, 2020 – The Pittsburgh Milliones facility is now closed until Friday, December 4. The District closed the school after two school employees have tested positive for COVID-19 within a 14-day period. The closure will affect the Grab and Go at the site. Students and families can access the Grab and Go at Pittsburgh Miller, located at 2055 Bedford Avenue.

The Milliones parking lot will continue to serve as one of five sites for distributing holiday meals on November 24, from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM and November 25, from 10:00 AM-12:00 PM and then again from 4:00 – 6:00 PM.

Arsenal Facility Closure Extended to November 30

Pittsburgh Arsenal is now closed until November 30. The facility recently reopened this past Friday, will close for additional days after two Pittsburgh Arsenal PreK-5 staff members test positive for COVID-19. Even though the staff members were last in the facility November 13, additional time is needed to ensure sufficient contact tracing. The closure will affect the Grab and Go located at the facility. Families may travel to Pittsburgh Obama for Grab and Go meals.

In Other News - Obama Football Families Notified of Positive Case

Families of the Pittsburgh Obama football team were notified today that a player on the team is presumed positive for COVID-19. The player is exhibiting symptoms of the coronavirus after being exposed to positive cases. As an added precaution, team members and coaches will quarantine until November 28. Communication was also shared with Pittsburgh Brashear families since both teams played in the District's Consolation game on November 14.
